Tasting Notes : *Intense and limpid bright ruby robe. On the nose, great variety of spice, bark and red fruit flavors, in particular berries and morello cherry stones. There is also a light hint of eucalyptus. Altogether plump, rosy and structured by well constituted tannins with a lot of persistence which guarantees potential for ageing.*
